

2019 Scholarship Update!

The National Auctioneers Association Auxiliary has exciting news! We will be continuing the Scholarship Program which began in 1993. Below are the requirements and other information regarding the awarding of the 2019 scholarships. The application is also included with this letter. A minimum of three scholarships of \$2,500.00 each will be awarded at the 2019 International Conference and Show in New Orleans, LA in July during the NAA Auxiliary Luncheon.

The Auxiliary Scholarship Program benefits members by assisting their children and/or grandchildren as they pursue higher education. The NAA Auxiliary is in its twenty-seventh year of providing this prestigious award.

Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- A child /step child or a grandchild/ step grandchild of a current Auxiliary Member with membership three out of the last five years.
- Candidates applying must be graduating from an accredited high school and have been accepted into a qualified college or university undergraduate study program or a school of technology or candidates must have completed the past year at a qualified college, a university or a school of technology.
- Candidates can apply for this program more than once, but can only be awarded the Auxiliary Scholarship one time.
- Auxiliary Scholarship Applications are available on the NAA Auxiliary website or by email request to the scholarship chair.

- The application must be completed and returned with all supporting documentation via email NO later than March 1, 2019. NAA Auxiliary parent/grandparent membership will be verified after applications are received.
- Applicants will be notified via email by May 15 of scholarship award status.

2019 NAA Auxiliary Scholarship Application

The NAA Auxiliary will award up to three scholarships in the amount of \$2,500 each to qualified candidates. Scholarships are payable for use in the 2019/2020 school year.

Who is eligible?

- A child/stepchild or grandchild/step grandchild of an Auxiliary Member in good standing and a member since January 1, 2014 (3 of 5 consecutive years).
- Candidates applying must be graduating from an accredited high school and have been accepted into an undergraduate study program or a school of higher education; or candidate must have completed the past year at a qualified college or university or school of technology.
- Candidates may apply for the scholarship as many times as desired but can only receive the Auxiliary Scholarship for a maximum of one (1) year.

Scholarship Requirements

Please provide responses to items 1-5 below and attach to this application. Please number each section 1-5. Be as specific as possible.

1. Write a 800-1000-word essay including the subjects below:
 - a. Tell us about yourself and what makes you unique. What special talents do you have? What are your interests? Any involvement with the auction industry, NAA or NAA Auxiliary?
 - b. Describe your future plans and how you will accomplish them. What career or vocation you hope to pursue? What college/university you have chosen? What major and/or minor have you chosen to help accomplish your goals?
 - c. Choose a person who has inspired you and tell us why. If there is one person, whether alive or deceased, that you could talk to who would it be? What do you hope to learn from this person?
2. List and detail all school and extracurricular activities in which you have participated. Include any honors or awards in these areas.
3. List and detail community service/volunteer activities in which you have participated. Include any honors or awards in these areas.
4. List and detail work experience (paid work: give days and hours)
5. Include 3 letters of reference. Can be from religious leaders, teachers, school officials, coaches, community leaders, etc. (do not include letters from family members).
